NOTIFICATION

The 18th July, 1998

No. 35763—IIW-Legis.-1/98/R.—Whereas the draft of certain rules further to amend the Orissa Irrigation Rules 1961 were published as required by sub-section (1) of section 53 of the Orissa Irrigation Act, 1959 (Orissa Act 14 of 1959), in the Extraordinary issue No. 823 of the *Orissa Gazette*, dated the 29th June 1998 under the notification of the Government of Orissa in the Revenue & Excise Department No. 31835-IIW-Legis.-1/98-R., dated the 29th June, 1998, inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby till the 15th July, 1998;

And whereas the objections and suggestions received on the said draft have duly been considered by the State Government;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 53 of the Orissa Irrigation Act, 1959 (Orissa Act 14 of 1959), the State Government do hereby make the following rules further to amend the Orissa Irrigation Rules, 1961, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Irrigation (Amendment) Rules, 1998.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Orissa Irrigation Rules, 1961, in the Schedule,—

- (i) in Part A Khariff Water rate, for the existing table, except the Paras. 2 and 3 thereof, the following table shall be substituted, namely:—
